LEADERS LETTER

...fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecta of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2

Dear Friend,

When Jesus hung on the cross, He was subject to intense abuse, humiliation and shame. Contrary to popular art depictions of the crucifixion, Jesus was totally naked. His body had been beaten beyond recognition and He had nine inch nails driven through His hands and feet. As He hung there His shoulders were dislocated and He struggled to breathe.

He was ruthlessly mocked by the soldiers who carried out these horrors. He had a crown of thorns thrust on His head so that blood was streaming down His face. He endured verbal, mental and physical abuse. Yet this scripture says He endured it all, the pain and shame.

What is amazing is that He did it for the very people who were doing this to Him, He did this for us and make no mistake it was our sin that put Him on the cross.

Greek scholar Rick Jenner notes that the word 'endure', comes from the Greek word 'hupomeno' and is a compound of the words 'hupo' meaning 'under' and 'meno' meaning stay, he states that the combination of these two words translates as someone who is under an incredibly heavy load, but refuses to stray from his task.

Jesus endured all this, even though He had all the power of heaven at His disposal.

1Peter 2:23 ... When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly.

Jesus did not try to escape, but endured the horror, for us.

If we do not know Jesus, if we have not committed our lives to Him and decided to follow Him, we are under Satan's power. Without Jesus we are under the curse of sin and are slaves to Satan's wishes for our lives. The shedding of the blood of the sinless lamb - Jesus Christ was the only way to set us free from Satan's bondage.

Jesus endured that death so we may have eternal life today. So if you do not know Jesus Christ yet or if you have drifted away from Jesus then I strongly implore you this very moment to commit your life to Jesus and escape Satan's death grip over your life. I implore you to accept the free gift of eternal life that Christ Jesus won for you on that cross of Calvary.
